Trail Signs

Re-route of trail going to Coleman

Jerry Frey at the last meeting told the club that the land owner west of the swamp would like us to change the route of the trail and has given him several options to accomplish it. Gene Duffy indicated that he has a contact with the Coleman club who wants to participate on this project. He will get that information to Jerry Frey.

Joco Lake Trail

Roy indicated perhaps this would be a good time to look into re-routing that part of our trail or we will have to build some bridges due to the running water. Tom Stadler was going to look into this potential trail change.

Highway 64 Trail

Chuck Panure indicated that he is looking into how we could re-route the trail and get off of Highway 64. He will be contacting the landowners in that area.

Trail Maps

Gene Duffy reported to the club that the clubs in Marinette County take a different approach to sell the trail maps. They charge the businesses up front an additional \$70.00 which the club keeps. The local business keeps the profit for selling the maps. In area the revenue from the maps is a donation that goes into our donation boxes. After much discussion it was determined to continue the way we handle the map sales.
